Note: Eligibility Criteria – these data were collected prior to the [March 2021 USPSTF update](#); at the time, USPSTF recommended screening for individuals ages 55 to 80 years who have a smoking history of 30 pack years and currently smoke or have quit smoking within the last 15 years.; Medicare covers screening of individuals ages 55 to 77 years who have a smoking history of 30 pack years and currently smoke or have quit smoking within the last 15 years; “Other” includes programs that have criteria that is similar but slightly different from USPSTF or Medicare, as well as programs that have no formal eligibility criteria for screening.

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
